EE Bushong Show Barn Undergoes Roof Replacement

With the support of the community and local businesses, the EE Bushong Show Barn is receiving a new roof. Construction began in September with the removal of the old tin, which was sold to the highest bidder following a competitive bidding process.

Repairs are being completed section by section, addressing areas of rot and strengthening the existing frame to ensure safety and longevity. The project is on schedule, with completion expected in October.

In addition, the RCJLSA office is currently being updated. Planned improvements include the installation of electricity and internet service. Once these updates are complete, the board will host a workday to set up the office, creating an efficient and functional space to support board meetings, show day activities, and the auction.
